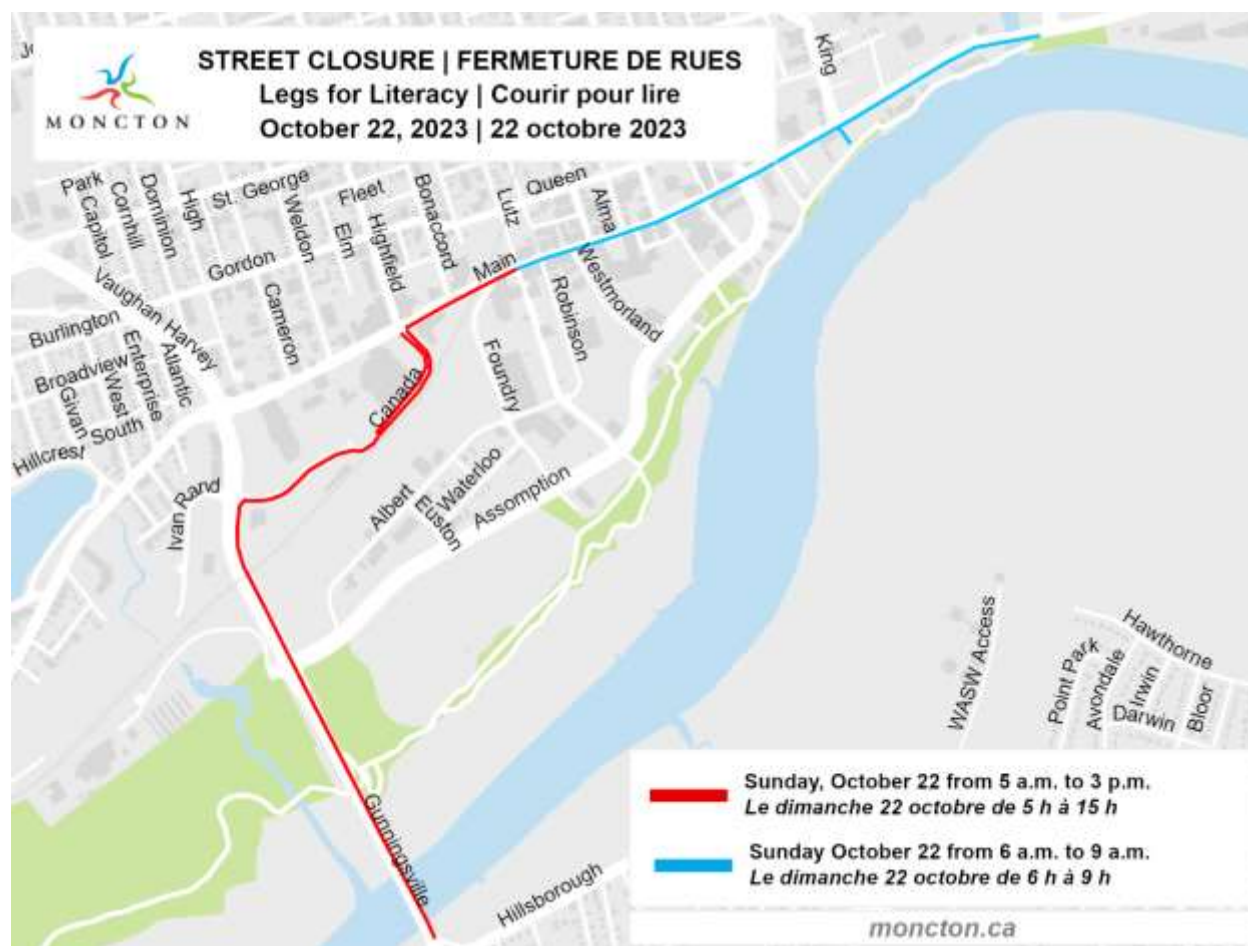

- Access will be permitted to the Hyatt Place Moncton / Avenir Centre for employees and patrons of the venue, hotel, and restaurant via Main Street.

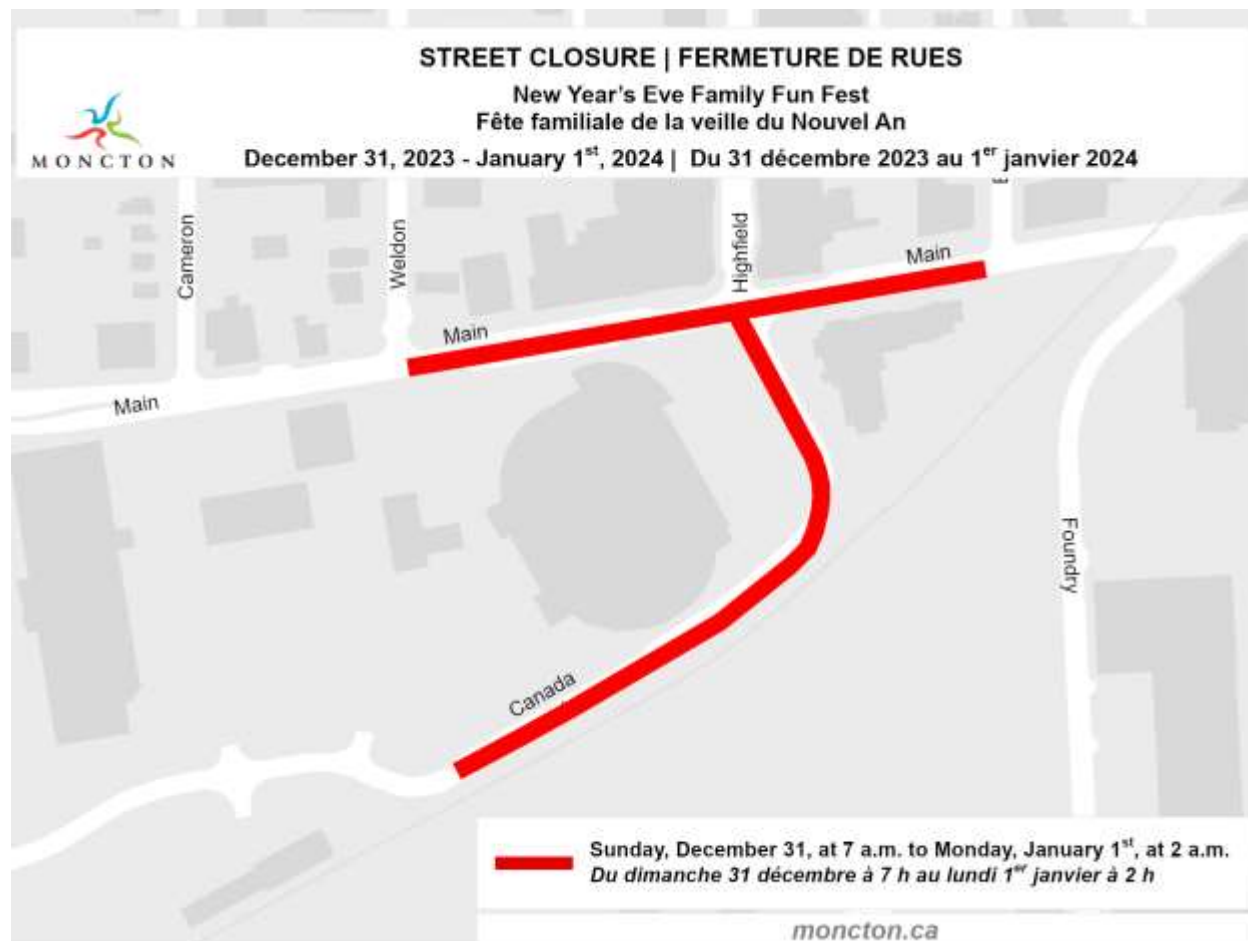
2. Greater Moncton Santa Claus Parade
